### THE ONE PERCENT



Water is a finite resource - even though about 70 percent of the Earth's surface is covered by water, less than 1 percent is available for human use. If glaciers or ice caps melt, our oceans will rise and its currents will change. As a coastal State, the implications of this occurrence will influence how we manage and consume freshwater. It's important that we all become "waterwise" because every drop counts.

What does the uncertainty surrounding water availability mean for you? Using water efficiently conserves sources for future generations and is critical to our economic future and human health. Changes in how we manage and use water can directly influence the potential savings on utility and water bills because delivering water and wastewater services are energy-intensive.

# **EVERY DROP COUNTS**

Did you know that the average American uses 100 gallons of water per day? Whether you are inside or outside your home, you can reduce your water use by as much as 30% by

#### taking a few simple steps.

#### Indoor:

- For those appliances that use water, *look for the ENERGY STAR*® *label*. Rebates are available for water heaters, boilers and washing machines.
- Do you have a leaky faucet or toilet? Household leaks waste more than 1 trillion gallons of water every year in the U.S. alone. Look for the <a href="WaterSense">WaterSense</a> label when buying new water efficient toilets and other products like faucets and shower heads.
- Every drop counts, **so don't allow water to run when not actively using it**: i.e. brushing your teeth, washing your hands or dishes.

#### Outdoor:

- **Plan and design** your lawn and landscape with lower water requirements (vegetation requiring minimal watering) and improve the efficiency of outdoor irrigation.
- Consider **xeriscaping**: the use of drought-tolerant plants and species native to your climate, requiring minimal watering

Remember, water is a nonrenewable resource, we have a finite amount to use and it requires expensive processing and treating. **Be waterwise.**

### **NEW REBATE ANNOUNCEMENT**

New Jersey's Clean Energy Program is now offering a \$500 rebate for the installation of Mini-split Cold Climate Heat Pumps. The cold climate heat pumps are a new technology providing very efficient heating at very low outdoor temperatures. There is an additional \$200 bonus (maximum 5 per household) if a cold climate mini-split heat pump is installed in homes with electric resistance heating, where natural gas service is not available. A cold climate mini-split heat pump can provide up to 40% savings in homes with electric resistance heating.

Provides financial and other incentives to the State's residential customers, businesses, local governments and schools that install high-efficiency or renewable energy technologies, thereby reducing energy usage, lowering customers' energy bills and reducing environmental impacts. In totality over the last fifteen years, New Jersey has invested more than \$3.1 billion in approximately 1.5 million energy saving projects that have reduced electric use by approximately 10% - enough energy savings compounded over 15 years to power about 3.1 million homes.
