Did you know that lighting represents 20% of your home's electricity bill? Stores throughout New Jersey are now offering instant rebates on ENERGY STAR® LED lighting products to promote energy efficiency. There is no paperwork re quired in order to receive the rebate.

An ENERGY STAR Qualified LED Bulb:

NEW JERSEY CLEAN ENERGY PROGRAM PARTNERS WITH THE EPA'S RESPONSIBLE APPLIANCE DISPOSAL (RAD) PROGRAM

The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities' Clean Energy Program is thrilled to have become a RAD Program Partner.

It is estimated that more than 11 million refrigerators/freezers, 6 million window air conditioning units, and 1 million dehumidifiers are disposed of annually in the United States.

Partners in EPA's RAD Program commit to collecting used refrigerated appliances and implementing best practices for the recycling/disposal of these units, which go
