FREE ENERGY CONSERVATION SERVICES



Home heating is a high-cost necessity in New Jersey. For people with low incomes, the decision to pay the utility bill may mean deciding between being warm in the winter or having well-balanced meals.

The Comfort Partners Program provides free home energy conservation services to eligible low-income homeowners and renters. The free cost-effective energy efficiency measures can include hot water conservation measures (water heater insulation, pipe insulation and energy-saving showerheads and aerators); replacement of inefficient refrigerators, thermostats and lighting; insulation upgrades (attic, wall, etc.); air and duct sealing; and heating/cooling equipment maintenance.
