NEW JERSEY SUPPORTS FAMILIES IN NEED

Over 90,000 of New Jersey's income-qualified residents have received assistance at no cost to help make their homes more energy efficient, and provide a safe, healthy environment for their families.

The Comfort Partners Program assists income-eligible households by installing energy efficient measures at no cost in homes to help lower energy bills. This can include lighting, water heater and pipe insulation, replacement of inefficient refrigerators; thermostats; insulation upgrades (attic, wall, etc.); air sealing; duct sealing and repair; and even heating/cooling equipment maintenance.
